Handgun Training Plus NM Concealed Carry Course Welcome Letter

This course is designed to be a basic training experience in handgun use for self-defense. The program also fully meets the requirements for a New Mexico concealed carry permit. This is a proven and effective training program.

Training is 9:00am to 5:00pm with a half hour for lunch, both days, unless otherwise notified. Day 1 in the classroom, all you will need is something to write with. If you have your own gun and holster, you may bring it if you like, if not, we have guns and holsters to lend you. Please bring any receipts you have for payment of the class, if you have not paid yet, we accept cash, check or credit card on the first day of the class.

Safety Information

There is no gun handling when in the classroom or the range without the instructor's authority. Upon arrival, all firearms shall be unloaded and cased. All guns must be unloaded with ammunition separate and boxed until instructions are received from the chief instructor. Absolutely no ammunition is allowed in the classroom.

All participants should remember the primary rule in using a tool or firearm; "If you do not know how to handle it, don't touch it". When handling a firearm follow the three NRA safety rules. 1.Always point your firearm in a safe direction. 2. Keep your finger off the trigger until you are ready to shoot. 3. Always treat all firearms as if they are loaded. A good cleaning is highly recommended for your firearms before attending the class. If you are new to firearms, limit handling prior to the class to avoid accidents. Negligent discharge of a firearm, menacing conduct (like horse play or threatening behavior), being under the influence of any drugs (prescription drugs also) are not tolerated.
